Stormwater Pollution Activity

- 1. Explain stormwater pollution to students.
- 2. Divide students into smaller discussion groups and assign each group a location.
 - a. Suggestions:
 - i. School
 - ii. Neighborhood
 - iii. Business
 - iv. Farm (Ranch or Vegetable)
 - v. Highway/Road
 - vi. Factory
- 3. Give each group 3-5 minutes to brainstorm what sort of pollutants from their place could be carried by rainwater to the river.
- 4. Optional: After the time is up, tell them they have another 3 minutes to talk about ways to keep one of those pollutants out of the water.
- 5. Have students share their pollutants and solutions (if applicable) with the rest of the class.
